## **IMPACT Herbicide Label Adds New Weeds, Simplifies Rotation Intervals**

Five additional grass and broadleaf weeds have been added to the list of controlled weeds on the label for IMPACT® postemergence corn herbicide from AMVAC Chemical Corp. for 2008.

Green foxtail, dandelion, Powell amaranth, horsetail (maretail) and hairy galinsoga are the new controlled weeds. Shattercane suppression has been added to the label.

Rotational cropping flexibility has been increased in Iowa, Illinois and Nebraska. Under the new label, the rotation interval for soybeans is 9 months throughout the three states when IMPACT is applied at 0.75 oz/acre. In the past, the northern portions of the three states had a 9-month soybean rotation interval at 0.5 oz/acre.

Added rotational cropping flexibility has been approved in a supplemental label for North Dakota and South Dakota. The proposed changes will allow rotation to soybeans 9 months after IMPACT when applied at 0.5 oz/acre. That rotation interval/rate structure is already in place in portions of South Dakota, as well as all of Minnesota, Wisconsin and Michigan.

Also under the new label, the list of tank mix partners has been expanded to include AIM® and Status® herbicides. Sequential applications of IMPACT following herbicides containing mesotrione now also can be made where corn will be planted the following growing season.
